A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE ROAD SALT FROM CARGILL INCORPORATED DE-ICING TECHNOLOGY THROUGH THE C.U.E.S. COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED FIFTY-ONE AND 47/100 DOLLARS (\$51.47) PER TON FOR THE 2016/2017 WINTER SEASON.

WHEREAS, the Supervisor of Public Service has recommended the purchase of road salt from Cargill Incorporated De-icing Technology through the CUE cooperative purchasing program at a price of \$51.47 per ton for the upcoming winter season, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Village to accept the recommendation of the Supervisor of Public Service, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Cargill Incorporated De-icing Technology through the CUE cooperative purchasing program at a price of \$51.47 per ton for the 2016/2017 winter season.

SECTION 2: That a copy of the Agreement shall be attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
