A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE RESIGNATION OF VICTORIA JEROMOS-BLAYNEY FROM THE VILLAGE OF REMINDERVILLE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Victoria Jeromos-Blayney has tendered her resignation from the Civil Service Commission, and

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to accept the resignation of Ms. Jeromos-Blayney effective December 31, 2017, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the resignation of Victoria Jeromos-Blayney from the Village of Reminderville Civil Service Commission is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure that a timely replacement to the Civil Service Commission may be made so that the Commission has a sufficient number of members to carry out its duties pursuant to the Charter, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
