A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SEITZ BUILDERS FOR WORK REQUIRED TO BE COMPLETED FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT RENOVATION PROJECT FOR A SUM NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$545,400.00).

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended entering into an agreement with Seitz Builders to complete work for the Police Department Renovation Project; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is good cause to accept the recommendation of the Police Chief, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute an Agreement with Seitz Builders for the completion of work for the Police Department Renovation Project for a sum not to exceed Five Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Four Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$545,400.00).

SECTION 2: That a copy of such Agreement shall be attached hereto and expressly incorporated herein.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
