

RESOLUTION NO. 22-2016

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF CATHERINE JACOBS TO THE VILLAGE OF REMINDERVILLE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Charter of the Village of Reminderville, a Civil Service Commission shall be created, and

WHEREAS, the Charter requires Civil Service Commissioners to be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council, and

WHEREAS, there presently exists a vacant seat on the Civil Service Commission due to the resignation of Rodney Wiggins, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayoral appointment of Catherine Jacobs to the Village of Reminderville Civil Service Commission for the unexpired term of Rodney Wiggins is hereby confirmed.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure that the Civil Service Commission has a sufficient number of members to carry out its duties pursuant to the Charter, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
