A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 93-2015 IN ORDER TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE FISCAL OFFICER TO PAY DIRECTLY TO POLICE CHIEF JEFF BUCK THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR AND 32/100 DOLLARS (\$35,984.32) TO BUY BACK A PORTION OF CHIEF BUCK'S ACCRUED SICK TIME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has found that there is good cause to buy back a portion (809 hours at the rate of \$44.48) of Chief Buck's accrued sick time (2,735.77 hours); and

WHEREAS, Chief Buck has requested, by memorandum dated March 8, 2016, that such payment be made directly to him instead of to his Deferred Compensation account, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

- **SECTION 1:** That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to pay directly to Police Chief Jeff Buck the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-Four and 32/100 Dollars (\$35,984.32) to buy back a portion (809 hours at the rate of \$44.48) of Chief Buck's accrued sick time (2,735.77 hours).
- **SECTION 2:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville to wit: in order to complete the "buy back" immediately, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
