A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A HVAC MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH JACKSON COMFORT SYSTEMS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended using Jackson Comfort Systems for HVAC maintenance, and

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to accept the recommendation of the Service Director, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a HVAC Maintenance Agreement with Jackson Comfort Systems.

SECTION 2: That a copy of Jackson Comfort Systems' HVAC Maintenance Agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure that there is no interruption or lapse in maintenance to the Village's various HVAC systems, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
