

RESOLUTION NO. 60-2016

A RESOLUTION TO HIRE SLOANE ROBOCKER AS A PART-TIME AQUATICS SUPERVISOR IN THE REMINDERVILLE RECREATION CENTER TO BE PAID AT THE RATE OF SEVENTEEN AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$17.00) PER HOUR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Director of the Reminderville Recreation Center, has recommended the hiring of an Aquatics Supervisor for the Reminderville Recreation Center, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Reminderville Recreation Center has recommended the hiring of Sloane Robocker to such position, and

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to accept the recommendation of the Director of the Reminderville Recreation Center, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Sloane Robocker is hereby hired as a part-time Aquatics Supervisor in the Reminderville Recreation Center. Such position shall be paid at the rate of \$17.00 per hour, not to exceed 29 hours per week, with an effective date of June 28, 2016.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure adequate workforce, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
