A RESOLUTION TO HIRE PAULA McKENZIE AS AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR FOR THE REMINDERVILLE ATHLETIC CLUB, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to accept Paula McKenzie as an independent contractor, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Paula McKenzie is hereby hired as an independent contractor for the Reminderville Athletic Club teaching Aqua Arthritis and PIYO, effective September 19, 2016 through December 31, 2016, to be paid at the rate of \$22 per class.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure immediately placement, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
