**Approval of Minutes**

Mr. DiCarlo moved to approve the minutes from March 28, 2017. Mr. Kondik seconded. All in favor except Mr. Hoffmann who abstained.

Mr. DiCarlo moved to add Resolution 38-2017 to the agenda. Mr. Silversten seconded. All in favor.

**TABLED LEGISLATION:**

**RESOLUTION 29-2017:** A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A THREE THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$3,000.00) DONATION TO THE TASTE OF TWINSBURG EVENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading. *Alonso*

Mr. Wiggins moved to take Resolution 29-2017 off Tabled Legislation. Mr. DiCarlo seconded. All in favor.

Mr. Hoffmann commented Council donated \$2,500 last year and feels they should donate that same amount this year. Mr. Silversten agreed. Mr. Hoffmann added they could use some for Reminderville Family Fun Day which is on the same day as Taste of Twinsburg. Mr. DiCarlo suggested voting it down because a donation request for the Bicentennial Founder's Day is going to be coming and they can use it on that instead. Mayor Alonso stated they need to think about what Reminderville gets out of donating to Taste of Twinsburg. Reminderville residents don't get anything special for going and he would rather use those funds to bring back the seniors Christmas dinner and add a bounce house to Reminderville Family Fun Day and know that the residents are getting something out of the funds. Taste of Twinsburg is essentially for restaurants to get their name and food out to the public. Mr. Hoffmann feels they should donate something. Mr. Kondik stated the Rock the Park and Luminocity events are celebrations for the residents while Taste of Twinsburg is a subsidized business promotion. He also stated the donation budget is \$5,000 for the year and they will be going over that.

Mark Curtis, Twinsburg Board of Education President, thanked Mayor Alonso and Council for giving him time to speak. He stated the levy is needed to backfill

for the money lost due to the property tax reimbursements being eliminated. He said the situation they are in today is not due to negligence on their part and they are very conscientious of every dollar they spend. They want to continue the excellence in education with the passage of the levy. He thanked the residents of Reminderville for their support.

Mayor Alonso stated the school systems are what drives house values in every community.
