Approval of Minutes

Owen Hetman Liberty Ledges

Mr. Hetman asked how he could join the committee working on the trails in the Village. He had heard that a trail was going to be behind his backyard and he is concerned about that. Mayor Alonso stated nothing has been planned out yet as to where the trails will go and he can contact Ms. Task to get information on the next Long Term Community Development meeting. Mr. Hetman also said he is a new resident and moved in thinking Liberty Ledges was in Twinsburg. Mayor Alonso said he saw the email Mr. Hetman sent to a Summit County Councilman and didn't appreciate Mr. Hetman portraying him as being underhanded with local

taxes and requesting an investigation on Reminderville all because Mr. Hetman was misinformed on where he bought his house. Mr. Hetman stated that was not what he meant and he just thought it was unfair there was no credit factor for local taxes. Mayor Alonso responded he has met with Ryan Homes in Liberty Ledges and told them to tell new homeowners they are in Reminderville, not Twinsburg. It is a Twinsburg zip code and it is in the Twinsburg school district but it is located in Reminderville. He continued that everyone pays the 1 ½ tax and no one gets a break. They are very responsible with the tax money and it is why the Village has its own full-time fire department and why the residents feel safe living here. He continued that the Summit County Councilman who replied to his email gave him incorrect information as well. He hoped Mr. Hetman would give the Village a chance to see how great it is to live here.

Mary Williams 10589 Florida Street

Mrs. Williams stated there are other people who think they live in Twinsburg or Aurora because of the zip codes and school systems. She tells people to make sure they put Reminderville on their driver's license and for their taxes. Mayor Alonso agreed and said they have to chase tax dollars when they are paid to the wrong city.
