## Call to Order

## **Approval of Minutes**

Mr. Walter moved to approve minutes from September 9, 2014. Mr. Kondik seconded. All in favor.

## **Mayor's Report**

Mayor Alonso reported Nautilus Trail is complete and the grass is starting to come in.

#### Law Director

Mr. Carpenter reported there is a request to rezone a 2.8 acre parcel on East Blvd. They will have to have a public hearing.

## **Engineering**

Mr. Esser reported on the change order for the Nautilus Trail project. The change order covered the sidewalk that was added, the additional safety forces used for traffic control, and utility line issues. The final increase was \$186,000. He will be going after Cleveland Water for some of the additional cost. The issue with the gas line is something Cleveland Water will have to deal with, with the gas company. He continued with the waterline project on Regatta Trail. He reported TriMor had the low bid and that is who he is recommending using. Their bid of \$966,000 which will be 100% covered by Cleveland Water. The decision will have to be made for Windjammer Trail & Cove as to just do the waterline and patch the road as needed or to do the waterline and repave. Assessments will be looked into if there is to be repaving. Mr. Hoffmann asked if they should

expect change orders for this project as well. Mr. Esser answered no, but if there are, he'll go to Cleveland Water and get the money. He said the Village was able to save over \$60,000 due to the rebidding of the project.

#### **Recreation Center**

It was determined that Mr. Walter will be the alternate if Mr. Hoffmann cannot attend rec center meetings. Mr. Hoffmann reported progress was made with the architectural design. There will be a presentation at the next meeting.

## **Fiscal Officer**

Ms. Wordell reported every employee in the Village is now on automatic payroll deposit. She continued that RITA representatives will be in Village Hall on October 3 to see residents who have been subpoenaed.
