John Eavenson from K. Hovnanian

I'm here to talk about the Herrington Place resolution. It's a preliminary plan approval, but we're really trying to get the phase cleared out so we can design Phase 7 and that phase will be a little smaller than what's been presented here tonight. We have an environmental clearing date of March 15 so we're trying to get ahead of that date and get started. Mainly what I ask is if we could get that resolution by emergency. Per the planning recommendation, we did ask that the city engineer provide an inspector to take a look at the areas that were staked along the property and they walked it with one of our supervisor this afternoon to make sure the lines delineated very well and there are no issues of going over the lines. Mr. Esser will contact the neighbors about clearing operations being started. I'd appreciate it if you would consider passing by emergency. Thank you.

Nate Bollinger from Clover Construction and Chuck Szucs from Polaris Engineering

Basically, Clover Management has been around for 25 years now. Eight years ago we decided we were going to start owning and operating our own buildings. We wanted it to be focused toward certain needs of senior. The senior population is growing by leaps and bounds and we decided to target all 55+ senior apartment buildings. We started building them; we have 25 up right now, six under construction with permits approved in Parma and Willoughby Hills. We are looking to do between 15-18 in the Cleveland/Akron area. Reminderville hits our key demographics. Basically this building will be 95 units, three stories, elevator, in-unit laundry, mostly two-bedroom. Market rate independent seniors, we are not subsidized by the state, we don't look for state funding, no HUD, no low income, we deed restrict the property so it will not be transferred out of that 55+ seniors. Parking will be one to one with no garages. Please let us know if you have any questions.
