

RESOLUTION NO. 106-2017

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH VASU COMMUNICATIONS, INC FOR THE PURCHASE OF MOBILE RADIOS TO BE USED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Village of Reminderville has Mutual Aid Agreements with a number of adjoining local municipalities, including the City of Aurora, and

WHEREAS, the City of Aurora has purchased new radios for their police department which are not compatible with the radios employed by the Reminderville Police Department, and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended purchasing radios that are compatible with Aurora PD's new radios to ensure officer safety, particularly during mutual aid calls, and

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to accept the recommendation of the Police Chief, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with VASU Communications, Inc. for the purchase of mobile radios/equipment for use in the Reminderville Police Department.

SECTION 2: That a copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3: That payment for such equipment shall be paid out of the General Fund.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
