A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDER #1 FOR TRI MOR CORPORATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,554.45 FOR WORK ASSOCIATED WITH TRENCH REPAIR ON GLENWOOD BOULEVARD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Tri Mor Corporation was awarded a contract to perform and complete trench repair work on Glenwood Boulevard, and

WHEREAS, additional costs have been incurred for which the Village Engineer has determined were necessary in the amount of \$24,554.45, and

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to accept the recommendation of the Engineer and approve Change Order No. #1 for work performed, or to be performed, on the Trench Repair Project, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Change Order No. #1 for Tri Mor Corporation in the amount of \$24,554.45 for work performed, or to be performed, that is associated with trench repair on Glenwood Boulevard is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure immediately placement, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
