**A RESOLUTION TO HIRE BRITTANY JICHA AS A PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER WITH THE VILLAGE OF REMINDERVILLE AND TO BE PAID AT THE RATE OF TWENTY AND 96/100 DOLLARS (\$20.96) PER HOUR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Police Chief has recommended the hiring of a part-time police officer for Reminderville Police Department, and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Chief has determined that Brittany Jicha is qualified and has met all the requirements for hiring into the Reminderville Police Department as a part-time officer, and

**WHEREAS**, Council finds good cause to accept the determination of the Police Chief, now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** That Brittany Jicha is hereby hired as a part-time police officer in the Reminderville Police Department, to be paid \$20.96 per hour, effective April 9, 2018.

**SECTION 2:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure immediately placement, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
