A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE FISCAL 2016 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-SIX AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$13,496.00) AWARDED FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO THE REMINDERVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Reminderville Fire Department has made application for and has been awarded a Fiscal 2016 Assistance to Firefighters Grant in the amount of \$13,496.00, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Council hereby accepts the Fiscal 2016 Assistance to Firefighters Grant in the amount of Thirteen Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-six and 00/100 Dollars (\$13,496.00) awarded from the Department of Homeland Security to the Reminderville Fire Department.

SECTION 2: That Council hereby authorizes and directs the Fire Chief to take all steps necessary to receive such grant.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to comply with conditions and/or requirements set forth in the grant award, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
