

ORDINANCE NO. 9-2018

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1329.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF REMINDERVILLE ENTITLED "CREATION; COMPOSITION; TERMS AND VACANCIES," AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is a need to amend Section 1329.01 of the Codified Ordinances, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Section 1329.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Reminderville which presently reads as follows:

"1329.01 CREATION; COMPOSITION; TERMS AND VACANCIES.

There is hereby created an Architectural Board of Review for the Village, to be appointed by the Mayor with confirmation by Council, to consist of five members, as follows:

- (a) Two members to be Councilmen to serve for the balance of their terms or one calendar year ending December 31 whichever is less; and
- (b) Three members to be qualified electors of the Village, to be appointed for terms of three years each as follows:
 - (1) One member to be appointed for the term ending December 31, 1987; one member to be appointed for the term ending December 31, 1988; and one member to be appointed for the term ending December 31, 1989.
 - (2) Thereafter, one new member shall be appointed each year, but in no case shall any member serve more than a three-year term without reappointment and reconfirmation by Council.

A vacancy occurring during the term of any member of the Architectural Board of Review shall be filled for the unexpired term in the manner authorized for an original appointment."

shall be amended to read as follows:

1329.01 CREATION; COMPOSITION; TERMS AND VACANCIES.

There is hereby created an Architectural Board of Review for the Village, to be appointed by the Mayor with confirmation by Council, to consist of five members, and one alternate member, as follows:

- (a) Two members to be Council members to serve for the balance of their terms or one calendar year ending December 31 whichever is less; and

- (b) Three members to be qualified electors of the Village, to be appointed for terms of three years each as follows:
 - (1) One member to be appointed for the term ending December 31, 1987; one member to be appointed for the term ending December 31, 1988; and one member to be appointed for the term ending December 31, 1989.
 - (2) Thereafter, one new member shall be appointed each year, but in no case shall any member serve more than a three-year term without reappointment and reconfirmation by Council.

- (c) One alternate member, to be a qualified elector of the Village, to be appointed for a term of three years. In no case shall an alternate member serve more than a three-year term without reappointment and reconfirmation by Council.
 - (1) In the event that there is not a quorum of regular members for a scheduled meeting of the Board, the alternate shall take the place of an absent member and shall have the authority to deliberate and vote on any motion before the Board for that scheduled meeting.
 - (2) In the event a vacancy occurs during the term of any member of the Board, such vacancy shall be filled by the alternate for the unexpired term of the vacated seat. Thereafter, a new alternate shall be appointed by the Mayor with confirmation by Council.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure immediate passage, and if this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
