

**ORDINANCE NO. 33-2017**

**OFFERED BY: Mr. Petrovich**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE SALARY PROVISIONS OF POLICE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31, 2017, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Council has determined that there exists good cause to increase the salaries of Police Department personnel, now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** That the annual salary of the Police Chief shall be \$98,508.47 plus \$2,953.60 for longevity totaling \$101,462.07 per year effective December 31, 2017. The Police Chief shall also be entitled to the use of a Village owned automobile.

**SECTION 2:** All promotions shall be reviewed and approved by Council.

**SECTION 3:** That the hourly rate of pay for a Captain shall be established by Council.

**SECTION 4:** That the hourly rate of pay for a Lieutenant shall be established by Council.

**SECTION 5:** That the hourly rate of pay for a Sergeant shall be 10 % more than that of a full-time police officer, effective December 31, 2017.

**SECTION 6:** That the hourly rate of pay for a full-time police officer off probation shall be 10% more than that of a full-time officer on probation, effective December 31, 2017.

**SECTION 7:** That the hourly rate of pay for a full-time police officer on probation shall be \$25.74 per hour, such amount to be the Police Department's "base rate of pay," effective December 31, 2017.

**SECTION 8:** That the hourly rate of pay for a part-time police officer on probation shall be \$20.96 per hour, effective December 31, 2017.

**SECTION 9:** That the hourly rate of pay for the Police Department Administrative Assistant shall be \$22.40 per hour, effective December 31, 2017.

**SECTION 10:** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**SECTION 11:** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to provide for passage prior to hiring new employees, and if this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
