

ORDINANCE NO. 36-2017

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS FOR THE REMINDERVILLE ATHLETIC CENTER TO \$51,500.00, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 31, 2017, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is good cause to increase the salary of the Director of Operations for the Reminderville Athletic Club, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the annual salary of the Director of Operations Aaron Tripp shall be increased to \$51,500.00, effective December 31, 2017.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to provide for passage prior to hiring new employees, and if this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
