A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE RESIGNATION FROM THE REMINDERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND REVOKE THE POLICE COMMISSION OF JUSTIN PHILLIPS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Officer Justin Phillips has tendered his written resignation from the Reminderville Police Department; and

WHEREAS, such resignation being accepted, Council hereby revokes the Police Commission formerly held by Officer Phillips, now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the resignation of Officer Justin Phillips is hereby accepted and the Police Commission formerly held by Officer Phillips is hereby revoked, effective May 24, 2018.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure adequate police protection to the residents of the Village of Reminderville, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
