

**RESOLUTION NO. 63-2018**

**OFFERED BY: Mayor Alonso**

**A RESOLUTION TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO TRI MOR CORP. FOR COMPLETION OF THE NAUTILUS TRAIL WEST RECONSTRUCTION & WATERLINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION, FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO THOUSAND, NINE-HUNDRED FORTY-ONE AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1,452,941.00), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Council authorized the Village Engineer to solicit bids for the Nautilus Trail West Reconstruction & Waterline Improvement Project, and

**WHEREAS**, the bids were advertised and opened pursuant to Ohio law, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Engineer, after reviewing such bids, determined that Trax Construction Company had submitted the lowest and best bid and that Tri Mor Corp. had submitted the second lowest bid, thus, recommended that a contract to complete such Project be awarded to Trax Construction Company, and

**WHEREAS**, Trax Construction Company failed to complete the project and, thus, were terminated for convenience, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Engineer has recommended that a contract to complete such Project be awarded to Tri Mor Corp., and

**WHEREAS**, Council finds good cause to accept the recommendation of the Village Engineer, now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** That Tri Mor Corp. is hereby awarded a contract to perform and complete the Nautilus Trail West Reconstruction & Waterline Improvement Project in an amount not to exceed One million, four-hundred fifty-two thousand, nine-hundred forty-one and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,452,941.00).

**SECTION 2:** That a copy of Tri Mor Corp.'s bid is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

**SECTION 3:** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Tri Mor Corp. for the completion of the Project.

**SECTION 4:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure commencement at the earliest possible time, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
