**Brian Bierwood 10242 Smugglers Cove**

Mr. Bierwood stated he has a concern about the water runoff in the ditch next to his property. He asked if there are any plans in place. Mayor Alonso said he and the engineers are getting pricing to dredge the ditches. He said residents need to stop dumping their leaves in areas that contribute to the flooding. He's hoping to get it done by December.

**Lynn Bierwood 10242 Smugglers Cove**

Mrs. Bierwood asked how the existing system in place will be changed or improved upon. Mayor Alonso said he will send the engineers out to discuss that with her.

**Mary Williams 10589 Florida Street**

Mrs. Williams said years ago they used to walk the ditches in the Shores and they would find bicycles, Christmas trees, and all sorts of debris. She asked if Council could draft legislation to cite homeowners. Mr. Carpenter said letters do get sent out to homeowners to clean out their ditches.

He said the culvert that crosses Smugglers, it sits up because they pumped the grout it and it raised it. Now there is standing water. Mayor Alonso said there has not been talk about that but he will send someone over to look at it.
