RESOLUTION 13-2019: A RESOLUTION TO PROMOTE JAMES SIEGFRIED TO THE POSITION OF LIEUTENANT IN THE REMINDERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT. 1st Reading. *Alonso*

RESOLUTION 14-2019: A RESOLUTION TO PROMOTE MICHAEL BERQUIST TO THE POSITION OF SERGEANT IN THE REMINDERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT. 1st Reading. *Alonso*

Mr. Wiggins made a motion to authorize the Police Chief to apply for a \$15,000 grant with 25% in matching funds for the purpose of purchasing bulletproof vests. Mr. Kondik seconded. All in favor.

Old Business

New Business

Mayor Alonso announced Councilwoman Becki Kovach gave birth to twin boys. He welcomed the young men to the family of Reminderville.

Chief Buck thanked Mr. Carpenter and said on several occasions, Mr. Carpenter had risked his life just to help the Village. He helped put people in jail for selling drugs or doing bad things; worked on his vacations to do arrest warrants; he was almost shot after they put someone away for 15 years; he had to search someone who had just robbed them because there weren't enough officers on site in another city; helped do search warrants on 21 felonies in a 24-hour period that put almost 30 people in jail. He thanked him for being by his side the whole time.

Mayor Alonso reported power is still out for 16 homes on Florida Street. Ohio Edison is working and it should be back on by Thursday. The RAC and Village Hall are available for those who need warm shelter.
