Call to Order

Approval of Minutes

Amendments to the Agenda

Mr. Hoffmann moved to add Resolution 32-2019 to the agenda. Ms. Kovach seconded. All in favor.

Mr. Wiggins stated as a point of clarification, Ms. Task wrote up legislation for all three candidates so it would be ready to be added to the agenda for whomever was selected.

Tom DiCarlo 10430 Herrington Drive

Mr. DiCarlo commented that the statement Mr. Wiggins read on behalf of Chief Buck, while it makes sense that people may do that, he will have to have a part-time officer available to cover shifts. If Council were to keep the ordinance as it is, when an officer retires you will have to hire a new officer so you would still be paying twice and paying more sick time out.

Mary Williams 10589 California Street

Mrs. Williams thanked the service crew for filling the pot holes on their street. She also said an officer should sit at Lake and Florida because there are cars driving very fast in that area now due to the detour.

ORDINANCE 09-2019: AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND COMBINE SECTIONS 139.02 AND 149.03 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF REMINDERVILLE, BOTH ENTITLED “SICK LEAVE” AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 1st Reading. *Hoffmann, Wiggins, Kovach*

Mr. Hoffmann moved to suspend the rules and pass by emergency. Mr. Wiggins seconded. All in favor.

Ms. Lohan said they can accept the passage by emergency and not suspend the rules so there can still be three readings. There are separate ordinances cited for each of those actions. Three readings allow for more discussion and input from the department heads or public. The emergency passage is to start the new sick time hours accumulation under the new conversion. The sick time hours accrued up until now will be paid out 100% at retirement as the current ordinance reads. All sick time hours accrued from this point on will cap out at 2,700 hours and be paid out 25% at retirement.
