

Exterior Concrete Specifications

All concrete pavements on private property and pavements not subject to vehicular traffic located in the public right of way is required to be a minimum thickness of four inches (4") of portland cement concrete with compactable base material that is a minimum of four inches (4") thick.

All concrete pavements subject to vehicular traffic in the public right of way (drive aprons and walk crossing a drive) is required to be a minimum thickness six inches (6") of portland cement concrete with compactable base material that is a minimum of four inches (4") thick.

Patios plans should provide dimensions and setbacks to property lines. Driveway plans for additions and/or extensions should provide the addition give the addition/or extensions as well as the overall dimensions.

In cases where the drive is widened on the apron and continues to the private property, the affected walk located in the public right of way must be removed and replaced with a 6' pavement
