

RESOLUTION NO. 03-2020

A RESOLUTION TO HIRE MASON EVERHART AS A PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER WITH THE VILLAGE OF REMINDERVILLE AND TO BE PAID AT THE RATE OF TWENTY-TWO AND 23/100 DOLLARS (\$22.23) PER HOUR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended the hiring of a part-time police officer for Reminderville Police Department, and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has determined that Mason Everhart is qualified and has met all the requirements for hiring into the Reminderville Police Department as a part-time officer, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is good cause to accept the recommendation of the Police Chief, therefore:

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Mason Everhart is hereby hired as a part-time police officer in the Reminderville Police Department, to be paid \$22.23 per hour.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to ensure immediate placement, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
