A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE NOTICE OF RETIREMENT OF POLICE OFFICER DANIEL CLEVINGER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Daniel Clevenger began his career with the Reminderville Police Department on September 25, 2012, and

WHEREAS, Officer Clevenger was instrumental in the advancement of other Reminderville police officers in developing their firearm skills and tactics by serving as a range instructor and providing a facility for Reminderville police officers to qualify their firearm skills, and

WHEREAS, Officer Clevenger has tendered a written notice of his intent to retire from the Reminderville Police Department, effective February 29, 2020, and Council hereby accepts same, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Village Council on behalf of the government and citizens of the Village, express their gratitude and appreciation for the dedicated service of Officer Daniel Clevenger to the Village of Reminderville and the community.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
