**WHEREAS,** Police Chief Berquist has recommended to Council that there is a need to trade in a 2013 Ford Interceptor police cruiser to facilitate the purchase of a new vehicle for use by the Police Department, and

WHEREAS, Council has good cause to accept the recommendation of Chief Berquist,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Statewide Ford Lincoln for the trade in of a 2013 Ford Interceptor police cruiser, VIN # 1FM5K8AR2DGA51424.

**SECTION 2.** That a copy of the Trade-In Agreement/subsequent Purchase Agreement shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof.

**SECTION 3.** The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4**. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to facilitate the purchase of a new vehicle at the earliest possible time, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
