AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF REMINDERVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Reminderville, Ohio;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the editing, arrangement and numbering of those ordinances and resolutions enacted by Council from April 8, 2019 to June 23, 2020, as listed in the Comparative Section Table, are hereby approved and adopted as printed in the 2020 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances so as to achieve uniformity of style and classification. A copy of such replacement pages is attached to this ordinance and incorporated as a part hereof.

SECTION 2: That the following sections of the Traffic, General Offenses and Building Codes, as amended, are hereby approved and adopted as amended or enacted so as to conform to enactments of the Ohio General Assembly:

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to keep Reminderville laws current with State provisions, and if this Ordinance receives the

necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
