WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to create the Summit County PSGP fund for the deposit of monies received by the Village of Reminderville from the Summit County Coronavirus Relief Distribution fund, designated specifically to receive distribution of share of CARES Act Relief Funding.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to establish the PSGP fund at the earliest possible time, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
