A RESOLUTION TO TERMINATE THE EMPLOYMENT OF RAC DIRECTOR THERESA NESS WITH THE VILLAGE OF REMINDERVILLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Mayor Alonso has advised that RAC Director Theresa Ness violated company policy, and

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to accept the determination of the Mayor, therefore

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the employment of RAC Director Theresa Ness with the Village of Reminderville is terminated effective August 17, 2020.

SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to ensure immediate termination, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
