**Call to Order**

Ms. Wordell stated Mayor Alonso, at the beginning of the pandemic, spoke with the department heads and asked them to reduce their budget and closely watch their spending. The department heads cut 15%-20% of their budgets and have been only making necessary expenditures plus the Village has received over \$265,000 in CARES Act funding, which puts the Village in a good place financially. As of September 3, the Village appropriations are at 57.5% for the year and revenues are at 77.9%.

Ms. Wordell continued for the 2021 budget, the department heads were told they could expect to receive the same budget or a bit less than they did in 2020. Mayor Alonso will review the 2021 department budgets and pass it to the Finance Committee for their review at the October 13 meeting.
