- **WHEREAS,** there are emergency repairs needed to Glenwood Boulevard east of Meriden Court in the Village, and
- **WHEREAS**, OHM Advisors has received a proposal from Tri Mor Construction for the emergency repairs, and
- **WHEREAS,** Council finds good cause to accept the recommendation of OHM Advisors to engage Tri Mor Construction to perform the emergency repairs, and therefore,
- **NOW, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:
- **SECTION 1.** That the proposal of Tri Mor Construction for the emergency repairs to Glenwood Boulevard is hereby approved and accepted.
 - **SECTION 2.** That a copy of such proposal is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- **SECTION 3.** Council finds that appropriations are available in Fund 2902 for Engineering Services.
- **SECTION 3.** The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
