Mayor's Report

Mayor Alonso yielded his time to Mr. Tucker.

Engineering

Mr. Tucker reported Mr. Feldkamp, who is in charge of opening the dam, tracked 5" of rainfall on Labor Day. Mr. Tucker was in the Village the next day taking notes of high watermarks on properties and houses and also spoke with residents. He stated there is FEMA insurance available and he will get the information to Village Hall for residents. There is a FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant but he does not feel the Village meets the criteria. He spoke about the National Flood Hazard Layer FIRMette Map which shows FEMA's data regarding flood levels and flood risk areas. There were streets that flooded in Aurora Shores that are outside of FEMA's flood risk areas. Mayor Alonso asked him to look into why the water is not flowing out of Metroparks and to investigate the retention ponds and box culverts. He also said with that much rain, if there is nowhere for the water to go, it doesn't matter what you do. Mr. Tucker said the

flood study would take a few months. He also reported TriMor will be doing another reseeding on Nautilus Trail and OHM will be submitting for grants for Clipper Cove and Smugglers Cove in November.

Service Department

Mayor Alonso reported they put out all of the mums throughout the Village and are getting the equipment ready for the first snowfall.

Reminderville Athletic Club

Mayor Alonso reported there are approximately 3,400 members currently. Ms. Kovach requested to see the number of swipes of members coming in pre-COVID compared to now. Mayor Alonso also reported Mr. Lohan is doing a great job and will have his consultation report ready for review soon.

Fire

Chief Plunkett reported they received the funding from the grants for the radios. He also stated the fire department is not a water mitigation program. They cannot pump out a flooded basement during a storm. They do not have the equipment to pump out thousands of gallons of water in numerous homes and if it is during a storm, there is nowhere to pump the water to if the streets are also flooded. They can pump out a basement in the case of a burst water pipe or a smaller storm when they can send the water to the street. They were out during the storm for rescue purposes to help if someone got caught in the moving water or if there are utility storm emergencies such as sparking outlets or power issues. You should always call 911 if you need help.
