Anthony Garcia 10175 Pirates Trail

Mr. Garcia stated he made a report of the locations that had sewage back-up from the flooding on Labor Day. He identified 38 homes, 23 of which are on Nautilus Trail. He hosted a meeting with residents to educate them about their rights and how to fill out the report form to send to Summit County. His report included a map with the affected houses and his observations from walking the areas where main sewer lines run and performing a visual inspection of the surface ground. His opinion is that there are several sunken areas and that DOSSS has a duty to fulfill its proprietary function to the community. He gave

copies of his report to the Council members, Mayor Alonso, and Ms. Lohan. Mayor Alonso thanked him for his work.
