A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE SUMMIT COUNTY COVID-19 LOCAL GOVERNMENT PAYROLL SUPPORT PROGRAM GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

- **WHEREAS,** the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136 (the "CARES Act") was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and
- **WHEREAS**, a previous resolution was passed by Council authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Summit County for the COVID-19 Local Government Payroll Support Grant Program to receive the Village's distribution of CARES Act funding; and
- **WHEREAS,** the County COVID-19 Local Government Payroll Support Grant Program provides that the Village shall only use Program Funds to fund payroll and benefit costs associated with public health and public safety employees, who have been deemed by the U.S. Treasury Department, as a matter of administrative convenience, as being substantially dedicated to mitigating or responding to the COVID-19 public health emergency; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Mayor has deemed the payroll and benefit costs associated with public health and public safety employees, who have been deemed by the U.S. Treasury Department, as a matter of administrative convenience, as being substantially dedicated to mitigating or responding to the COVID-19 public health emergency necessary to the Village's response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Village will allocate up to 15% of police officer, sergeant, and lieutenant's wages and benefits to the program from the period between March 1, 2020, to December 30, 2020, per the grant agreement; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Village will allocate up to 25% of firefighter/paramedic's wages and benefits to the program for the period between March 1, 2020, to December 30, 2020, per the grant agreement; therefore
- **NOW, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:
- **SECTION 1.** That funds commensurate to the amounts outlined above be appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Summit County COVID-19 PSPG Fund.
- **SECTION 2.** The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 3**. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: the Village needs to appropriate the funds as soon as possible, and if this Resolution receives the
