Call to Order

Approval of Minutes

Mr. DiCarlo moved to approve the minutes from October 13, 2020. Mr. Milani seconded. All in favor.

Mr. Wiggins started going through the payment register.
Mr. Wiggins moved to accept payments totaling \$75,885.41. Ms. McCaffery seconded. All in favor.

Mr. Wiggins started going through the bank statements for July and August 2020. Bank statements were reconciled without incident.

Mr. DiCarlo moved to accept July's bank statements. Mr. Milani seconded. All in favor.

Mr. DiCarlo moved to accept August's bank statements. Ms. McCaffery seconded. All in favor.

Mr. Wiggins continued the 2021 budget review. Ms. Wordell reported the revenue projections from R.I.T.A. are that Reminderville should expect 3% less than the revenue collected in 2020. Ms. Wordell continued that all of the 2021 department budgets are currently reduced by 20%. Mr. Wiggins stated the committee should review the information and bring their questions and concerns to the next meeting. Chief Berquist stated his concern about the 20% reduction

in his 2021 budget is they did not do training this year due to COVID and they will have to pick that back up next year. He also would like to retain the officers he has currently and not lose anyone to another department. Mr. DiCarlo said he likes the department budgets presented as a total number and the department heads can allocate the money into their line items as they see fit. Mr. Wiggins asked Ms. Wordell to create another budget showing a 15% reduction and giving 3% for personnel raises.
