A RESOLUTION TO HIRE INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS AS PERSONAL TRAINERS AND FITNESS INSTRUCTORS FOR THE REMINDERVILLE ATHLETIC CLUB, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Mayor Alonso has recommended hiring independent contractors as personal trainers for the Reminderville Athletic Club, and

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to accept the recommendation of Mayor Alonso, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Brian White is hereby hired as an independent contractor for the Reminderville Athletic Club to be a Personal Trainer, effective January 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021, and will accept payments from clients and pay the Reminderville Athletic Club 15% of the charged rate per hour/per client, and

SECTION 2: That Brenda O'Hara is hereby hired as an independent contractor for the Reminderville Athletic Club to be a Personal Trainer, effective January 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021, and will accept payments from clients and pay the Reminderville Athletic Club 15% of the charged rate per hour/per client, and

SECTION 3: That Elizabeth Lear is hereby hired as an independent contractor for the Reminderville Athletic Club to instruct Yoga, effective January 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021, and to be paid \$25.00 per class, and

SECTION 8: That Stacey O'Keefe is hereby hired as an independent contractor for the Reminderville Athletic Club to instruct 20/20/20, Silver Sneakers, TRX, and Power Hour, effective January 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021, and to be paid \$30.00 per class, and

SECTION 9: That Stacey O'Keefe is hereby hired as an independent contractor for the Reminderville Athletic Club to be a Personal Trainer, effective January 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021, and will accept payments from clients and pay the Reminderville Athletic Club 7% of the charged rate per hour/per client, and

SECTION 10: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure immediately placement, and if

this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
