

ORDINANCE NO. 2-2021

OFFERED BY: Mayor Alonso

AN ORDINANCE TO TRANSFER \$39,495.39 FROM THE GENERAL FUND (1000) TO THE OPWC DEBT FUND (3901), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to authorize the Village Fiscal Officer to make supplemental appropriations and transfers to reflect adjustments which were previously approved by Council and need to occur during the current fiscal year, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: Council hereby authorizes and directs the Village Fiscal Officer to transfer thirty eight thousand four hundred ninety five dollars and thirty nine cents (\$38,495.39) from the GENERAL FUND (1000) to the OPWC FUND (3901), to meet budgetary requirements.

SECTION 2: Any Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Ordinances or Resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. Any Ordinances or Resolutions or parts of Ordinance or Resolution not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: these funds are needed to cover expenses for the debt service payment and if this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
