

RESOLUTION NO. 02-2021

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE VOLUNTARY REDUCTION IN RANK FOR CAPTAIN RICHARD KAUTZMAN TO THE RANK OF FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC IN THE REMINDERVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Captain Richard Kautzman has voluntarily submitted his desire to reduce his rank with the Reminderville Fire Department from the rank of Captain to the rank of Firefighter/Paramedic, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is good cause to accept the voluntary submission of reduction in rank, therefore:

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Captain Richard Kautzman is hereby reduced to the rank of Firefighter/Paramedic with the Reminderville Fire Department.

SECTION 2. That Firefighter Richard Kautzman's new hourly rate of pay shall be twenty-two and 39/100 dollars (\$22.39) per hour.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to prevent interruption of the committee's duties, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
