## A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 69-2020 CLARIFYING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THOSE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE COVID-19 HAZARD PAY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** Resolution 69-2020 was intended to compensate employees with Hazard Pay for the exposure of employees to individuals potentially infected with COVID-19 during the time period beginning on March 1, 2020 and ending on December 30, 2020, and

**WHEREAS**, the intention of Resolution 69-2020 was to place certain limitations upon Village of Reminderville's employee's eligibility to receive hazard pay; and therefore,

**NOW, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

- **SECTION 1.** That hazard pay is authorized only for full-time and part-time employees, excluding seasonal and temporary positions, of the Village of Reminderville who were currently and actively employed with the Village on December 30, 2020.
- **SECTION 2.** The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 3.** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council. If this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
