Spring flowers for the Village have been ordered. Resolution 16-2021 is for a new dump truck. The current truck is constantly under repair and they are worried it will not last to the end of the year. The new truck will take seven months to build and they are hoping to have it for next plow season.

Ms. Rockhill reported she is getting quotes for roof repairs and has met with a commercial pool company for supplies and repairs. She has started planning for summer camp and will be following State guidelines.

Mr. DiCarlo reported the next JEDD meeting is on March 2 at 7:00 at the Township.
