AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE RATE OF PAY FOR JONATHAN HERRERA AS SUPERVISOR IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO TWENTY-FOUR AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$24.00) PER HOUR, EFFECTIVE MAY 30, 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is good cause to increase the hourly rate of Supervisor Jonathan Herrera, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

- **SECTION 1:** That the hourly rate for Jonathan Herrera is hereby increased to \$24.00 per hour, effective May 30, 2021.
- **SECTION 2:** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to provide for passage prior to hiring new employees, and if this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
