AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORATE OF AMENDMENTS TO SECTIONS OF THE CHARTER RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF COUNCILMANIC DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, in 2012, the electorate voted to amend the Charter to repeal/abolish councilmanic districts, and

WHEREAS, the Charter Review Commission recommends and Council desires to change the Charter to re-establish councilmanic districts, and

WHEREAS, Council desires to submit amendments to sections of the Charter that would effectuate the above referenced change to a vote of the electorate at the November 2, 2021 election.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Reminderville hereby and herein submits for consideration by the electorate, amendments to Sections 4.02, 4.03, 4.04, 4.11, 4.13, and 4.15 to re-establish councilmanic districts within the Village. A copy of said amendment is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Board of Elections of Summit County, make the necessary arrangements with the Board of Elections, and give the required notice to the Village's electors for the proper placement of this Amendment on the ballot for the November 5, 2021 Election.

SECTION 3. That the question presented to the voters shall be as follows:

Shall Sections 4.02, 4.03, 4.04, 4.11, 4.13, and 4.15 of the Charter of the Villa	age
of Reminderville be amended to re-establish councilmanic districts.
