

RESOLUTION NO. 39-2021

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE NORTHEAST OHIO PUBLIC ENERGY COUNCIL (NOPEC) COMMUNITY EVENT SPONSORSHIP IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE-THOUSAND FIVE-HUNDRED AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1,500.00), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Reminderville is a member of the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) and is eligible for the 2021 NOPEC Community Event Sponsorship funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. This Council of the Municipality finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the Municipality to accept the NOPEC Community Event Sponsorship funds to be used at a community event in 2021.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to ensure immediate placement, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
