## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT AND TRACK LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS AUTHORIZED BY THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

- **WHEREAS**, The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Pub. L. No. 117-2) (ARP), a \$1.9 trillion economic COVID-19 stimulus package, was signed into law on March 11, 2021, providing additional relief to address the continued impact of COVID-19 on the economy, public health, state and local governments, individuals, and businesses; and
- **WHEREAS**, as part of this package, \$350 billion in additional funding is being provided to state and local governments; and
- **WHEREAS,** in order to receive these funds, non-entitlement units of local government must take certain actions, including: execution of the award terms and conditions agreement, Assurances of Compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act Of 1964, and establishment of a separate fund to track receipts and expenditures of the funds; and
- **WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code §5705.09 requires subdivisions to establish separate funds for each class of revenue derived from a source other than the general property tax, which the law requires to be used for a particular purpose.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, Summit County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:
- **SECTION 1**: The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund Terms Agreement attached hereto as "Exhibit A", and the Assurances of Compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act Of 1964 attached hereto as "Exhibit B".
- **SECTION 2:** The Fiscal Officer of the Village of Reminderville shall establish the following Special Revenue Fund: "Local Fiscal Recovery Fund" using Fund number 2902.
- **SECTION 3.** The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 4:** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, for the reason that it is necessary to have a fund in place to receive, disburse and track American Rescue Plan Act funds at the earliest time possible, and shall become effective immediately upon its passage by at least two-thirds of the members elected to the Village of Reminderville Council.
