**AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE TAX BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR
COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2022 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Law, Council is required to pass an ordinance approving the tax budget for each Village fund, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Council, in order to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village during the fiscal year commencing on January 1, 2022 and ending December 31, 2022, hereby set the Tax Budget as attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Reminderville, Ohio for the reason that these appropriations are needed to meet purchasing requirements of the remainder of the year.
