WHEREAS, Brian Lloyd has tendered his resignation from the Reminderville Fire Department, and

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to accept the resignation of Brian Lloyd from the Reminderville Fire Department, now, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the resignation of Brian Lloyd from the Reminderville Fire Department, effective September 14, 2021, is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville, to wit: to insure adequate police protection to the residents of the Village of Reminderville, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
