

**RESOLUTION NO. 69-2021**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE POLICE CHIEF, ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF REMINDERVILLE, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES BODY-WORN CAMERA GRANT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio, through the Office of Criminal Justice Services (OCJS) administers financial assistance for police departments, and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department of the Village of Reminderville, desires the financial assistance of the OCJS, and is eligible to apply for a grant in the amount of \$33,382.36 to help purchase and maintain body worn cameras, and

**WHEREAS**, Council has found that there is good cause to authorize the Police Chief to submit an application for the Body-Worn Camera Grant Program offered by The Office of Criminal Justice Services, and to authorize the Police Chief to accept if awarded and execute all other non-contract documents necessary to effectuate receipt of the grant, now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** That the Police Chief is hereby authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the Village of Reminderville, to submit an application for the Body-Worn Camera Grant Program offered by The Office of Criminal Justice Services for the amount of \$33,382.36.

**SECTION 2:** That the Police Chief is authorized to accept said grant, if awarded, on behalf of the Village of Reminderville Police Department, and is authorized to execute all other non-contract documents necessary to effectuate receipt of the grant.

**SECTION 3:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville to wit: in order to file prior to the deadline, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
