AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CITY OF REMINDERVILLE CODIFIED ORDINANCES AS RELATED TO THE CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that several sections of the City of Reminderville Codified Ordinances as related to the City Fire Department have become obsolete, therefore,

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Codified Ordinance Nos. 141.05, 141.08, 141.12, and 141.14 (b)(1), of the City of Reminderville are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Reminderville for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council. If this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
